

Hawke's Bay Vape Day Competition Rules and Important Information for the Competitions

Build Competition

The build competition is a chance to show off your skills, with both a beginner and expert level everyone is welcome to enter a coil, however all entries must abide by the following rules.

1. All entries must be in by 2pm on 10 November 2018.
2. Coil/s must not be used. You may fire the coil to colour said coil but must not be used. Any used coils will be disqualified.
3. The coil/s must be installed on an atomiser deck, but have no wicking or juice.
4. There is no resistance limit. But its resistance will still be tested.
5. The coil/s can be decorative and not intended for actual vaping.
6. Judges decisions are final
7. No conversations will be entered into about the final decision.

Show and Shine

The show and shine is all about showing off the vape most unique to you. Whether this your box mode, tube mode, or a mode that you have customised. It can be rare or just unique to you, basically if you want to show it off, enter it and show it off.

Show and shine entries must abide by the following rules.

1. All entries must be in by 2pm on 10 November 2018.
2. Judges decision is final
3. No conversations will be entered into about the final decision.
4. You must include a small blurb about your vape, including the make and model and what makes it special to you.

Cloud Competition

The cloud competition is all about blowing the biggest cloud, and having the right juice, build and mod combo to create it.

Prior to the event, all entries must have their build tested for resistance and have their batteries checked. This can be done at the HB Vapour Help Desk. The time for this will be announced by the event MC prior to your competition draw. If your build is considered unsafe by the judges, you will be given 30 minutes to rebuild and recheck. Please check this before you enter, to avoid disappointment for everyone.

All builds will be checked on the same device, supplied by the host of Hawke's Bay Vape Day, Hawke's Bay Vapour.

The back to back draw will be random, and the winner will then proceed through to the next round. Judge will base their decision on the size, density and distance of your cloud. Please exhale at the end of the countdown. Do not lean forward, as this could result in disqualification. Any pairing that is too close to call, will be asked to switch their positions with their competitor and face the other direction, and compete again. The competitors will be given 3 opportunities to blow the best cloud. Judges must come to a unanimous decision, and the decision is final.

Below are specific rules for each class.

Beginner

1. Open to anyone beginners
2. Open to any device - must be safe
3. NO Tank is permitted to run on hybrid mechanical mods
4. Tanks on mech mods with a 510 pin top are allowed, however they must comply with resistance limits per battery/s used.

Tank Class

1. This is an open class for all devices running a tank atomiser.
2. Includes pre built and/or factory coils, RTA and RDTA
3. NO Tank is permitted to run on hybrid mechanical mods
4. Tanks on mech mods with a 510 pin top are allowed, however they must comply with resistance limits per battery/s used.

Single 18650 Mechanical Tube Class.

1. Open entry to any single 18650 mechanical mod
2. You are allowed to use any RDA, RDTA, RTA
3. No Tank is permitted to run on hybrid mechanical mods
4. All builds must comply with the set build limits
5. Low build limit is non-negotiable
6. Limits are set off MCD Ratings (Manufacturers Continuous Discharge Ratings)

Any Mechanical Mods that use 20700 and 21700 should be entered into the open class.

Open Class

5. Open to anyone and anything
6. You are allowed to use any RDA, RTA, RDTA
7. All builds must comply with the set build limits
8. Low build limit is non-negotiable
9. Limits are set off MCD Ratings (Manufacturers Continuous Discharge Ratings)

MCD Ratings to be announced.

Blind Juice/Tasting Competition

Ready to test your best juice against others in the industry. Submit your best juice for judging and see who comes out on top. Just bring 2x30ml bottles of your best juice in 0mg nicotine on the day, and hand in to the Help Desk. Each ticket will get one vote and the winner will be announced at prize giving.

1. All entries must be in by 2pm on 10 November 2018.
2. All entries must be kept confidential. You must keep the description of your juice private. If you are heard discussing your juice, you will be disqualified and no conversation will be entered about the disqualification.
3. Judges decisions are final
4. No conversations will be entered into about the final decision.
